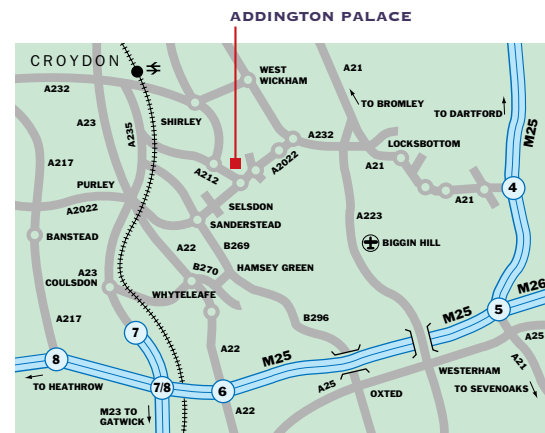

HOW TO GET TO ADDINGTON PALACE

The entrance to Addington Palace is on the southbound carriageway of Gravel Hill (A212), Addington, about 3.5 miles from East Croydon.

There is a frequent train service taking just 15 minutes travel time from Victoria and London Bridge Stations to East Croydon. From the station to Addington Palace is only 6 minutes drive by taxi.

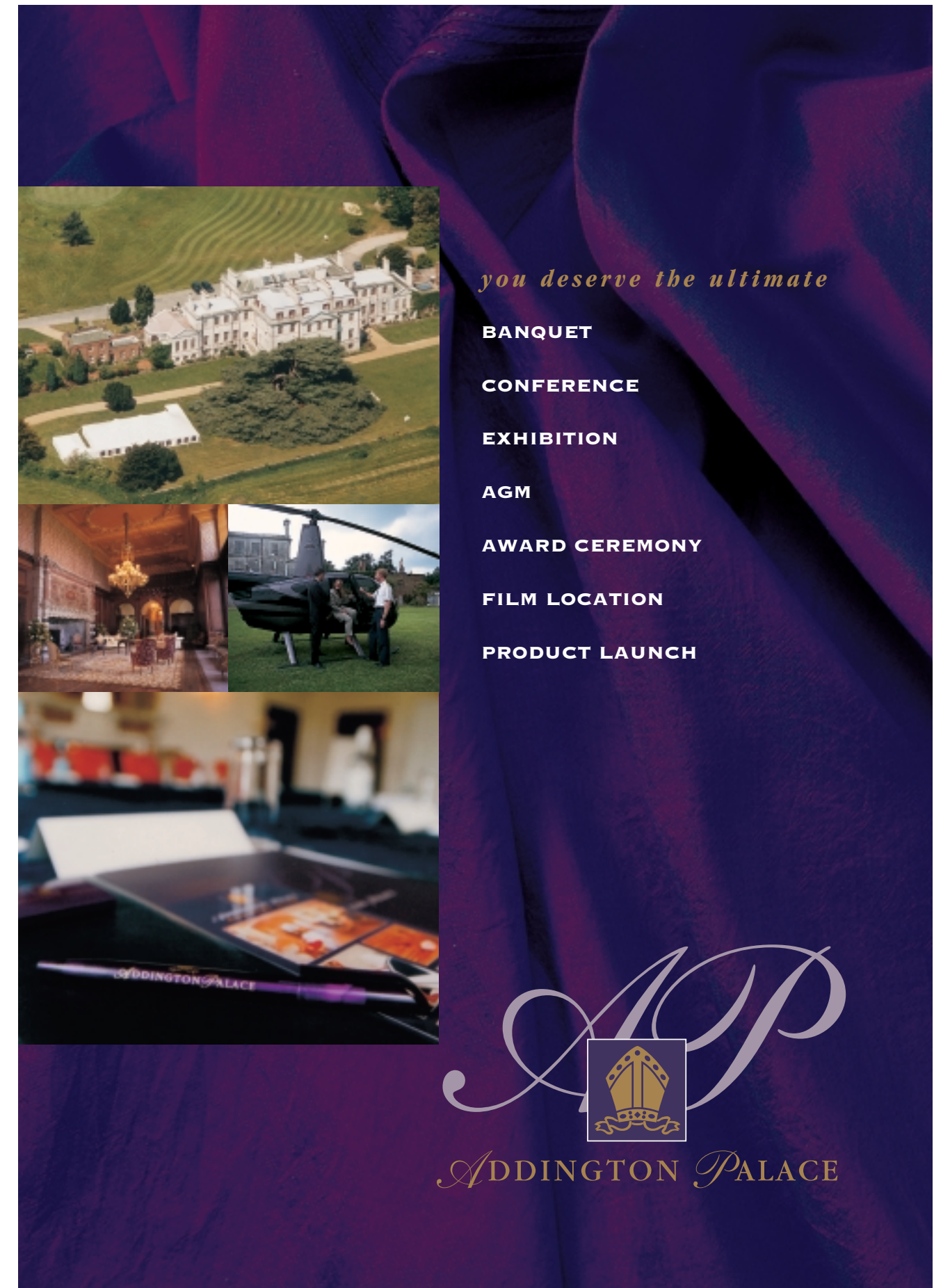
It is also 6 minutes by tram on the New Addington route from East Croydon Station to the Gravel Hill stop in front of the entrance to Addington Palace.

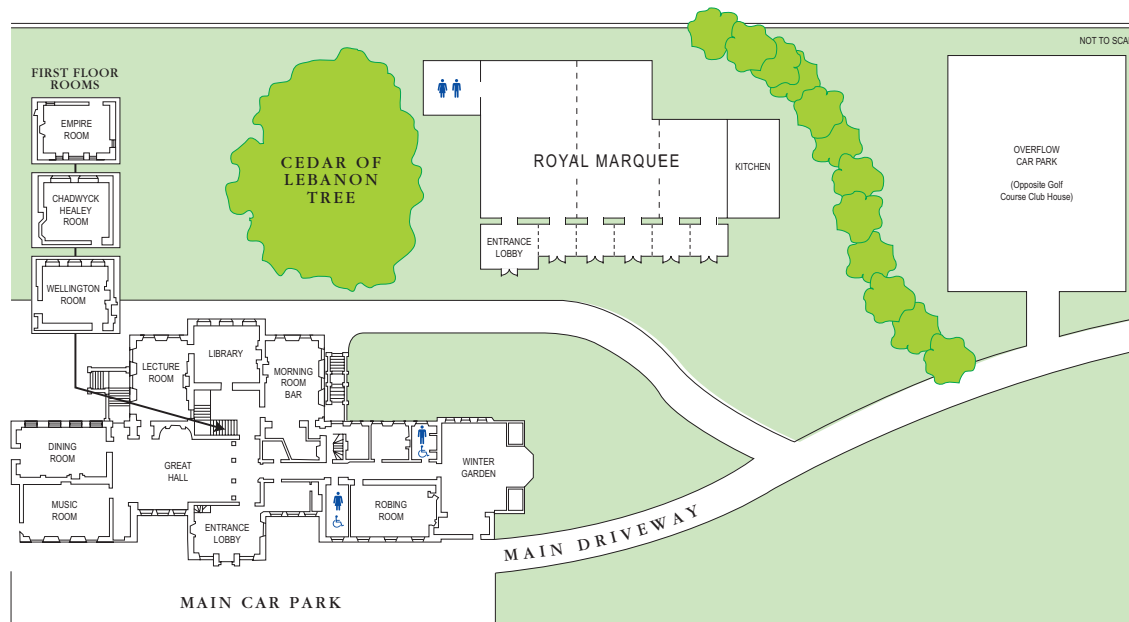

THE ROYAL MARQUEE



The Royal Marquee is a semi permanent De Boer structure and is Surrey's largest function room. Providing a stylish and versatile venue with the flexibility to accommodate presentations, product launches, award ceremonies and corporate fun days, the centre can accommodate 600 theatre style and 750 for a banquet.

Approached by its own gravel drive, it is fully heated and has a self-contained bar, cloakroom, kitchen and toilet facilities.

The changeable chandelier lighting is complimented with floodlights and flame lighters. The Royal Marquee is easily accessible for vehicles making set up a simple procedure.

The surrounding gardens can be used as additional areas for product displays, outdoor catering, entertaining or team building activities.

There are five flexible syndicate rooms, which can be opened up to create larger areas for breakout sessions, product displays or for use as catering areas.
